- Be 16 years old, held permit for a minimum of six months
- Have completed driver education
- Have completed 6 hours of professional driver training
- Have completed 50 hours of practice with an adult

Steps To Get Permit (For students under 18)

- Be at least 15 ½
- Complete the application form DL 44
- Provide your SSN and Birth Certificate
- Provide the driver education certificate
- Pay the application fee
- Pass a vision exam
- Pass a traffic laws and sign test
